# Food Cart Review

To decide site assignments for the 2007 season

**New Applicants - September 30<sup>th</sup> - Saturday**

- Be prepared to serve review panel members between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. Go to the site that you have been assigned on the enclosed map.
- Plan to have your cart or tent in place by 7 a.m. New applicants will be assigned temporary sites on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard and will not be open for business to the general public.
- Put the “Not Open to Public” signs in your windows. If the City of Madison Health Department has not yet inspected you, call 294-5338 to schedule an appointment as soon as possible.

**To All Food Vendors**

About 15 or 20 food cart review panelists will visit you during the hours listed above during the week or on Saturday. Each reviewer will have an ID card and will visit your cart or tent only once. Reviewers may arrive alone or in small groups. You may serve regular portions of food or drink, but panelists may request smaller portions. There will be no charge to the panelists for items served to them.

Before the food review begins, you will receive a checklist of panelists. It is possible that not all persons named on the list of panelists will evaluate you. That’s OK. It’s the average of your scores that will matter, not how many times you are evaluated. Do not give free food to anyone not named on the list or to anyone without this year’s ID.

Do not serve food or beverages in any way that is different than your usual method. If you are planning to make changes to your menu for next season, serve such new items to food reviewers only and not to the general public. Currently licensed vendors may not otherwise make major menu changes until the 2007 season.

Your site requests for the season beginning April 15, 2007 have been noted. As stated in the Regulations, regular vendors will be assigned sites prior to assigning sites to those vending only on Saturdays.
