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Mission, Goals and Objectives

Representing the citizens of the city of Madison, the Common Council will promote the safety, health and general well-being of our community within the bounds of fiscal responsibility while preserving and advancing the quality of life resulting in exceptional civic pride.

Section 3.55 Madison General Ordinances, establishes the Office of the Common Council and provides for the staffing and management of the Office. The Office currently operates with an Administrative Assistant and a Secretary 1, who perform various clerical, administrative and management staff functions for members of the Council. Staff holds office under Civil Service. The Administrative Assistant is appointed by the Common Council President with approval of the Common Council Organizational Committee. Other office staff is appointed by the Administrative Assistant. The office operates under the general direction of the Council President, or in the President's absence, the President Pro Tem. Section 3.55 authorizes alderpersons to assign duties to the office.
