The Commission may during the course of this hearing convene into closed session for one or more of the following purposes, authorized as noted by Wisconsin Statutes: deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of a quasi-judicial hearing, WS 19.85(a); considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation of a public employee, WS 19.85(1)(c); considering matters which are or may become the subject of collective bargaining, WS 19.85(1)(e); considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons, WS 19.85 (1)(f); conferring with legal counsel with respect to litigation, WS 19.85(1)(g). The Commission may thereafter reconvene into open session.
