The City of Madison will be holding three public meetings to receive input on the Brittingham-Triangle Green Project. Possible future improvements in the area will be discussed, focusing on West Washington Avenue between Park and Regent Streets (including the intersections of these streets), Brittingham Park, and possible pedestrian/bicycle connections through the Triangle. Below is a brief description of each meeting:

Kick-Off Meeting: Wednesday, September 3 - 6:00-7:30 p.m.

This meeting will include a presentation on the project guidelines, goals and objectives, schedule and process. It will also include an overview of the project area and observations made by the consultant team.

Public Open House: Thursday, September 4 - 6:00-7:00 p.m.

This meeting will be an "open house" format where interested parties may stop in and spend as much time as they would like discussing their ideas and comments on design approaches with the consultants, City staff, and others. There will be no formal presentation.

Public Open House: Friday, September 5 - 1:00-3:00 p.m.

This meeting will begin with a short presentation providing an overview of the project and the concepts and implementation strategies that evolved during the design process. The remainder of the time will be devoted to an "open house" format where interested parties may stop in and spend as much time as they would like discussing their thoughts on the concepts with the consultants, City staff, and others.
