Alicia Ashman Branch Library

Wards 82, 101, 119, 120, 127, 129, 132

Vote in Meeting Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

American Family Insurance

Wards 8, 9

Vote in Madison Room. Primary entrance for voters is last entrance in back, and is accessible.

Bjarne Romnes Apartments

Ward 52

Vote in Community Room on Lower Level. The City will designate a van-accessible parking space. Primary entrance is accessible.

Black Hawk Middle School

Ward 25

Vote in Library Media Center (LMC). Primary entrance is accessible.

Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church

Ward 65

Vote in Lower Level of Church/School. Primary entrance is accessible.

Boys and Girls Club of Dane County

Wards 53, 106

Vote in Harris Room. Signage on Election Day will direct voters to the entrance off Taft Street. Boys and Girls Club will fix gap in ramp and post the appropriate signage for accessible parking before Election Day. The City of Madison will provide a temporary ramp for the van-accessible parking space. The City of Madison provides a bell call on Election Day. Signage will be posted on Fisher Street, directing voters to the entrance off Taft Street.

Bridge – Lake Point – Waunona Community Center

Ward 54

Vote in Front Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Brittingham Apartments

Ward 49

Vote in Meeting Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Capitoland Christian Center

Ward 91

Vote in Left Side of Gym. Primary entrance is the main entrance at front of building and is accessible.

Chavez Elementary School

Wards 92, 135

Vote in Room 102C. Primary entrance is accessible.

Crestwood Elementary School

Ward 75

Vote in Lounge (Room 102). Primary entrance off rear parking lot is accessible. The school custodian will post signage on fence and use cones to designate a van-accessible space for Election Day.

Dane County Neighborhood Intervention

Wards 55, 56

Vote in Gym. The City of Madison provides a bell call and the inside door is propped open on Election Day.

Doyle Administration Building

Ward 44

Vote in Auditorium. Accessible parking and entrance are in rear parking lot closest to Bedford Street. Signage will be posted at Dayton Street, indicating that the accessible parking and entrance are off Bedford Street.

Dudgeon Center for Community Programs

Wards 66, 116

Vote in First Floor Commons. Primary entrance for voters is off rear parking lot and is accessible.

Eagle Heights Community Center

Ward 63

Vote in Room 101. Primary entrance is accessible.

East High School

Ward 32

Vote in Room 30. Fifth Street entrance is the primary entrance for voting. A bell call will be placed at the Fifth Street entrance. Signage will be posted at East Washington Avenue to direct voters to the accessible parking along the apron on the terrace, by the Fifth Street entrance.

Elvehjem Elementary School

Wards 3, 4, 131

Vote in West Hall by Gym B. Primary entrance is accessible.

Elver Park New Shelter

Wards 99, 107, 114, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125

Vote in Reserved Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Falk Elementary School

Wards 95, 96, 137

Vote in Front Entrance. Primary entrance is accessible.

Fire Station #1**Ward 42**

Vote in Utility Room. Primary entrance is off W. Dayton Street. The City of Madison provides a bell call. The City Clerk's Office is working with the Fire Department to provide an accessible parking space on Election Day.

Fire Station #6**Wards 57, 117**

Vote in Community Room (Lower Level). The City of Madison will provide a bell call on Election Day. The door into the voting area is propped open.

Fire Station #8 – Lien Road**Wards 16, 17, 18, 118**

Vote in Apparatus Floor. Primary entrance is accessible.

First Congregational Church**Wards 60, 61**

Vote in Student Lounge on first floor. Primary entrance is accessible.

Gates of Heaven**Ward 39**

Vote in Main Entrance off E. Gorham Street. Signage will direct voters to parking in lot behind building, off E. Gorham Street. A van-accessible parking spot is designated with cones on Election Day. Bell call will be placed at bottom of slope in front of building on Election Day. A new polling place is being sought due to the slope in front of the building.

Glendale Elementary School**Ward 1**

Vote in Library Media Center (LMC). Primary entrance is accessible.

Good Shepherd Lutheran Church

Ward 87, 88

Vote in Fellowship Hall. The primary entrance is off rear parking lot and is accessible. Voting is just inside the main door. The City of Madison will provide two signs, one to be posted at each side of parking lot, directing voters to the primary entrance.

Gordon Commons

Ward 45

Vote in Room A1, at west end of Gordon Commons. Primary entrance is accessible.

Hawthorne Branch Library

Wards 12, 13

Vote in Community Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Head Start

Ward 68

Vote in Multi-Purpose Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Heritage Congregational Church

Wards 90, 93, 102, 103

Vote in Fellowship Hall off Side Entrance. Primary entrance is accessible.

High Point Church

Wards 81, 83, 100, 104, 105, 109, 110, 112, 113

Vote in Micah Center. Primary entrance for voters is the side entrance off parking lot on right side of building and is accessible.

Hill Farm State Office Building

Ward 73

Vote in Main Entrance. Primary entrance is accessible.

Holt Commons

Ward 62

Vote in Lower Level Cafeteria. Primary entrance is accessible.

Hoyt School**Wards 70, 71**

Vote in Room 13. Primary entrance is accessible.

Huegel Elementary School**Ward 89**

Vote in Hallway near Office. Primary entrance is accessible.

Jefferson Middle School**Wards 79, 80**

Vote in Cafeteria. Primary entrance is accessible.

Kennedy Elementary School**Wards 5, 6, 111, 115, 139**

Vote in Activities Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

LaFollette High School**Ward 10**

Voting in Computer Room off Main Entrance. Primary entrance is accessible.

Lake City Church**Ward 2**

Vote in lower level. The rear entrance is the primary entrance for voters and is accessible.

Lapham Elementary School**Ward 38**

Vote in Hallway outside of Auditorium. New signage will be posted on Election Day to direct voters to the parking lot off E. Mifflin Street. Accessible entrance for voters is off this parking lot at the side of the school; path to polling location is marked with arrows.

Leopold Elementary School**Wards 58, 59**

Vote in Lobby. Primary entrance is accessible.

Lindbergh Elementary School

Ward 24

Vote in Gym. Primary entrance is accessible.

Madison Area Technical College – Downtown Campus

Ward 41

Vote in entrance off Dayton Street. Primary entrance is on Dayton Street and is accessible. The City of Madison will post a sign on Carroll Street and a sign on Wisconsin Avenue, directing voters to the Dayton Street entrance. The City Clerk's Office is working with Traffic Engineering on a plan to bag meters on Election Day, designating a drop off area for voters with disabilities and parking for vehicles dropping off voters with disabilities.

Madison Area Technical College – Commercial Avenue

Ward 14

Vote in Commons. Primary entrance is accessible.

Madison Ice Arena

Wards 97, 98, 126, 128, 130, 134

Vote in Conference Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Madison Municipal Building

Ward 36

Vote in First Floor Lobby. Primary entrance is accessible.

Madison Police Department – West District

Ward 94

Vote in Community Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Madison Public Library

Ward 43

Vote in Meeting Room on second floor. Primary entrance is accessible. The City Clerk's Office is working with Traffic Engineering on a plan to bag meters on Election Day, designating a drop off area for voters with disabilities and parking for vehicles dropping off voters with disabilities.

Memorial Library

Wards 40, 46

Vote in Room 116. Primary entrance for voters is on Langdon Street and is accessible. Signage is posted on Langdon Street, indicating that parking is across the street at UW Memorial Union.

Mendota Elementary School

Wards 22, 23

Vote in Main Entrance. Primary entrance is accessible.

MG&E Innovation Center

Ward 85

Vote in Lower Level Conference Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Midvale Elementary School

Ward 69

Vote in Front Entrance. Sign is posted at parking lot entrance off Caromar Drive, directing voters to the primary entrance on street side. Sign is posted in front of school, directing voters to accessible parking. The City of Madison provides a bell call at the primary entrance (main entrance to the school).

Muir Elementary School

Ward 78

Vote in Main Entrance by Office. Primary entrance is accessible.

National Guard Armory

Wards 15, 21, 133

Vote in Drill Room. Rear entrance off parking lot is the primary entrance for voters and is accessible. Follow the signs to the entrance.

New Beginnings Alliance Church

Wards 7, 136

Vote in Lower Level. The entrance off parking lot is the primary entrance for voters and is accessible.

O'Keefe Middle School**Ward 34**

Vote in Cafeteria. Entrance off Spaight Street is the primary entrance for voters and is accessible.

Odana Hills Club House**Ward 84**

Vote in Area inside Main Entrance. Primary entrance is accessible. A sign is posted at the main entrance, indicating accessible parking.

Olbrich Botanical Gardens**Ward 33**

Vote in Atrium. Primary entrance is accessible.

Porchlight, Inc**Ward 48**

Vote in Dining Room. Van-accessible parking is at the rear of building off the alley. The accessible entrance with ramp is clearly marked on Election Day and has an automatic door opener.

Sandburg Elementary School**Wards 19, 20, 108, 138**

Vote in Room 203. Primary entrance is accessible.

Sherman Middle School**Ward 31**

Vote in Gym (wood floor). Primary entrance is accessible.

Spring Harbor Middle School**Ward 74**

Vote in Room 7. Primary entrance is accessible.

St. James Catholic School**Ward 50**

Vote in school basement. Primary entrance is accessible; take elevator to basement.

St. Paul Lutheran Church

Ward 30

Vote in Fellowship Hall. Entrance off rear parking lot is the primary entrance for voters and is accessible.

Stevens Elementary School

Wards 76, 77

Vote in Main Entrance by Office. Primary entrance is accessible.

Tenney Park Apartments

Ward 37

Vote in Community Room. Additional lighting has been added along the walkway to the building. A bell call is located by the primary entrance on Election Day.

Thoreau Elementary School

Ward 67

Vote in Library Media Center (LMC). Accessible parking is off Cherokee Drive, in the school's rear parking lot. The City of Madison will post a sign on Nakoma Road, indicating that accessible parking is off Cherokee Drive. Both doors have automatic door openers. The City of Madison will post a sign at the elevator, directing voters to the second floor LMC.

Toki Middle School

Ward 86

Vote in Front Entrance – Hallway going away from Elementary Office. The primary entrance for voters is the main entrance into the school, off Russett Road. Accessible parking is in the rear parking lot off Whitney Way. The rear entrance has an automatic door opener, and the hallway inside the school is clearly marked with signs directing voters to the polling area. The City of Madison will provide a sign to be posted on Russett Road, directing voters to the parking lot for accessible parking.

Trinity United Methodist Church

Ward 51

Vote in Lower Level Fellowship Hall. Primary entrance (off West Parking Lot) is accessible.

UW Memorial Union**Ward 47**

Vote in Paul Bunyan Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

Van Hise Elementary School**Ward 72**

Vote in Main Entrance, by Elementary School Office. Primary entrance is accessible.

Warner Park Community Recreation Center**Wards 26, 27, 28, 29**

Vote in Meeting Room. Primary entrance is accessible.

West High School**Ward 64**

Vote in Gym. Primary entrance for voters (Van Hise Entrance) is accessible. Signage indicates accessible entrance off side parking lot.

Whitehorse Middle School**Ward 11**

Vote in Cafeteria. Primary entrance is accessible.

Wil-Mar Neighborhood Center**Ward 35**

Vote in Yahara Room. Primary entrance is accessible and marked with a "Voter Entrance" sign. Voters should not be using the ramp as an entrance. A bell call is used at the primary entrance. Just inside the primary entrance there is an elevator that will take the voter up to the polling area.
