

#### In the Presidential Preference Vote:

- You may vote for only ONE candidate.

- If you choose a party, votes cast in that party will be counted.
   Votes cast in any other party will not be counted.
- If you do not choose a party and you vote in more than one party, no votes will be counted.

#### Special Instructions for Presidential Preference Vote

Choose the party in which you will vote. Within the party you have chosen, you have ONE of three choices:

- Vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot in the party you have chosen.
- 2. Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen.



## Selecting a Party is a **Safety Net**

- If tabulator says there is a cross-over vote, the voter may select a party to save their ballot
- The ExpressVote does not allow cross-over votes



#### **Quick Guide to Checking ID**

Review this before checking voter IDs. We check ID at the poll book, per the WI Elections Commission.

#### 1. Be respectful. Offer to check voter's ID while the other official finds their name on the poll book

- Never make comments about how good or bad someone looks in their photograph.
- Never make comments about changes in weight, hairline, etc.
- IDs contain confidential information. Only poll workers may examine a voter's ID.
- ✓ Confidential voters are exempt from showing ID. Instead, they show you a confidential voter card issued by the City Clerk's Office.

#### 2. Make sure the type of ID is acceptable - one of the following:

- √ Wisconsin driver license expiring after 11/8/2022
- No hole punched through expiration date
- . A license that says "Valid Without Photo" is acceptable. These cards are issued to residents with sincere religious beliefs against being photographed.
- √ Wisconsin ID card expiring after 11/8/2022, or non-expiring
- . An ID card that says "Valid Without Photo" is acceptable. These cards are issued to residents with sincere religious beliefs against being photographed.
- ✓ U.S. passport (book or card) expiring after 11/8/2022
- ✓ Military ID card expiring after 11/8/2022, or non-expiring
- ✓ Certificate of naturalization issued within the last two years
- √ Unexpired Wisconsin driver license or state ID receipt
- ✓ ID card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe, regardless of expiration
- √ Student ID issued by a Wisconsin accredited college or university
- · If expired, accompanied by proof of current enrollment
- · Has student's signature

#### Opening Task A Voting Booth Set Up



All voting booths must be set up. The Clerk's Office delivered the number of booths you need to set up. State law requires one voting booth for every 200 voters your polling place had for the last November election.

Keep booths separate from other activities such as checking in and registering. Ask the chief inspector if they want you to set up a booth or table for provisional

- · Unlatch and open the voting booth case.
- . Remove all 8 legs from inside the voting booth. The legs are folded in half with a cord inside that connects the two tubes into one.
- . Insert the legs into the sockets located on the outside of the voting booth case. It may be easier for two officials to help one another, as the legs tend to fall out.
- · Place booth in its place and adjust its stance. Unfold and place privacy screens into slots.

#### Accessible Voting Booth

The accessible booth must be setup with a clear path. There should be a five-foot turning radius for mobility devices. Make sure the front legs are wider than the booth itself.

- If yes, make sure absentee is for your ward.

"Are you the voter?"

■ If no, "Are you delivering this ballot because the voter determined they need help returning it due to their disability?"





## **Absentee Deliveries**

- If yes, "Are you someone other than the voter's employer, an agent of that employer, or an officer or agent of their union?"
- If yes, accept ballot if it is for your ward.
