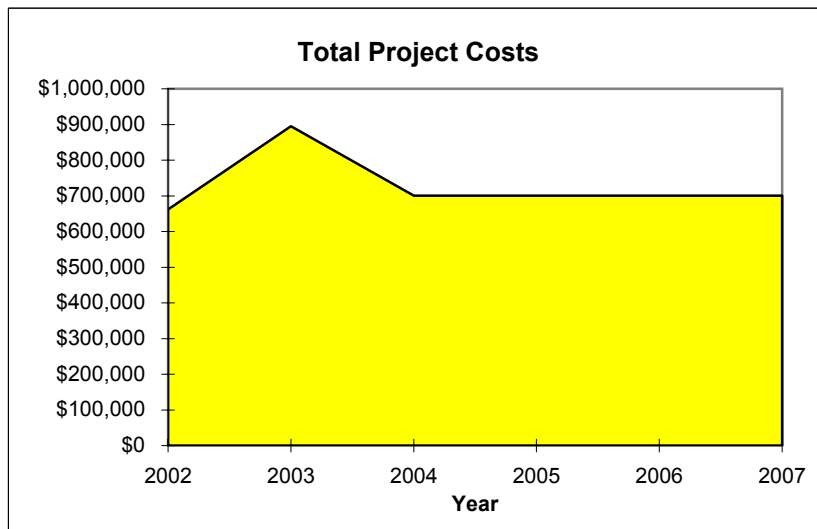

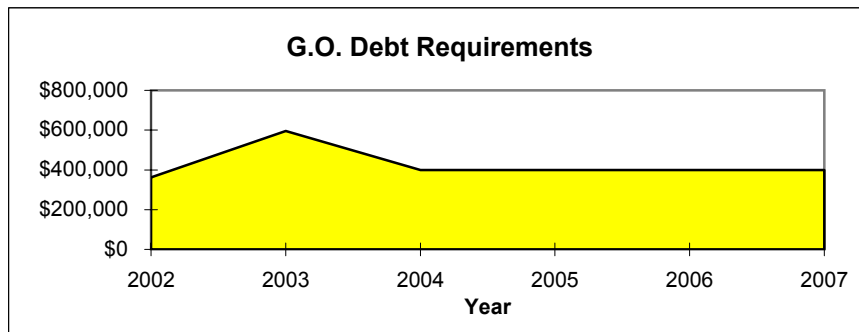

#### Reverse Mortgage Program

This project represents the continuation of a City-administered reverse mortgage program that enables elderly homeowners on fixed incomes to utilize equity in their homes to pay all or a portion of their annual property taxes. Eligibility guidelines are the same as for the City's special assessment deferral program. Other funding is from the Special Assessment Revolving Fund.

#### Municipal Art Fund

The Municipal Art Fund is a continuing program to be used to commission and purchase works of art to be displayed in public areas. All expenditures and projects related to the commissioning and purchase of artwork must be funded with at least a 50 percent match from the private sector, of which at least one-half of the match (one-fourth of the total project costs) must be cash. (Note: This project has been moved to the Planning and Development capital budget.)

#### General Land Acquisition

The General Land Acquisition Fund may be used for the land acquisition portion of various projects. These purchases may be completed to the extent that funds are available and specific common council approval is obtained. Other funding may include proceeds from the sale of surplus City-owned real estate, as well as available funds.

**Legislative Workflow Software**

This project would represent the purchase by the Department of Revenue of a software package that would electronically manage documents in the Clerk's Office and facilitate legislative workflow. Preferably, the system would be "web-enabled." The proposed system would enable users (staff, elected officials, and the general public) to track and view pending or adopted legislation by simple field, complex field, or full text search criteria, narrow the selection and highlight item they would like printed, and view legislative meeting history of items, including minutes, attached reports, motions, and votes. The system would electronically consolidate legislative files, allow users to add items to existing legislative files, update and make last minute changes to files and agendas, and review active ordinances and resolutions. In addition, the system would provide a common standard for all boards, committees and commissions to follow in preparing agendas and minutes.
