The neighborhood-based ad-hoc Royster-Clark Steering Committee has been working diligently to make sure that as the City begins its planning process and that resident input is heard.

Right now, a team is working to put together a neighbor-to-neighbor survey to learn your hopes for the site. Hopefully this survey will be conducted and tabulated early in the planning process.

**Schenk Street Traffic Calming**

Now that Schenk Street has successfully been through the City's Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP), an initial meeting of residents of Schenk Street was held to discuss the various options.

Residents who attended selected principally speed humps as a speed deterrent. A plan will be drafted by the City's Traffic Engineering Division and mailed to all households. Each household also gets a ballot to verify that this plan is what they wanted when they entered the NTMP last year. Sixty percent of all returned votes must support the new plan.
