



### ♦ What is a cube?




- Live connection to MUNIS in Excel
- Allows analysis and monitoring of City's financial data
- Uses pivot tables

### Which cube do I use for this?

Cube Type	Best Used For
General Ledger: Projection Cube	Operating Budget Development
General Ledger: Revenue and Expense	Operating Budget Monitoring
Project Cubes	Capital Project Monitoring
Payroll HR/Cubes	Salary, Position, Vacancy Analysis

### Chart of Accounts: What is it?

The framework for recording and reporting the City's financial transactions.



### **Project Ledger: What is it?**

The framework for recording and reporting transactions operating projects (such as grants) and capital projects and programs.

#### **Major Project:**

Ongoing program or project with multiple components

**Project**: Specific project or one-year of ongoing program

Expense and Funding Strings:

Identify the expenditure type(s) and funding source(s)

Expense String: Land Improvements (130)

Funding String: GO Bonds (801)

Funding String: Transfer from Impact Fees (902)

Funding String: Transfer from Other Restricted (907)

Athletic Field Improvements (MUNIS 17235)






## Go to Data Tab > From Other Sources > From Analysis Services

### 2. Conquer the Data Connection Wizard





### Cube Tips and Tricks

- Should be able to email cubes to others, and their Munis access should drive what they can see.
- Refreshing is a blessing and a curse. To keep an artifact, break the connection – Excel > Data > Connections > Remove.
- When first creating a cube, check it against the Munis Account Inquiry to make sure it is in line with expectations.
- Note: Cubes have a one day lag.

### Reference: Cube Glossary

- Segment 3: Agency
- Segment 4: Service
- Character code: Major
- Encumbrance: Money that is obligated to be spent but has not be spent
- Requisition: Money that is on its way out the door
- Project String Type: Indicates whether the string is for expenditures or revenues, helpful filter
