

The City of Madison's **Community Development Authority (CDA)** owns and manages Parkside High-rise Apartments and Parkside Townhouses under HUD's Multifamily Housing Program.

Parkside Apartments offers one-, two-, and three-bedroom units for eligible low-income families whose head, spouse, or co-head is disabled or at least 62 years of age. Families with minor children may also be given preference for two- and three-bedroom townhomes. Some units are wheelchair-accessible.

Rent is income-based.

Rent is affordable and based on income. Residents pay no more than 30% of their adjusted income for housing. A rent reduction/utility allowance is given when applicable.

Support services available.

Nurses from Meriter and St. Mary's Hospitals provide health screening, health education and social activities, as well as preventative emergency planning services. Two HUD Service Coordinators offer information and resource referral. An affordable lunch is served 5 days a week to all residents.

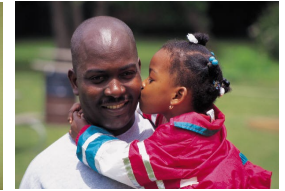

Applying for Parkside:

1. Fill out the pre-application completely, sign and date, and return to the address listed on the front of the pre-application.
2. You will be placed on a waiting list, mailed a receipt letter, and provided with an estimated wait time. The CDA waiting lists are kept by bedroom size, and applicants are ranked according to the date and time of application and verified preferences. The CDA will give a preference in any of the following situations if proper documentation is submitted:
 - You live, work, or go to school in the City of Madison or Dane County.
 - You are homeless or a victim of domestic violence.
 - There are minor children in your household.
 - You are 62 years of age or older.
 - You are a person with a disability.

3. While you are on the waiting list, you must notify the CDA of these changes:
 - Mailing address
 - Phone number
 - Gross monthly income
 - Family composition
4. When the CDA is ready to screen your file, you will be sent a *full application* along with a list of required documents and several release forms to be signed by all adults in the household.
5. All applicants will be screened for eligibility. The CDA screening process includes:
 - Full criminal background check.
 - Verification that you do not owe money to nor have been terminated by another housing authority.
 - References from your current and previous landlords.
 - Review of your credit history.
6. You will be notified by mail when a determination has been made.



Eligibility

Initial eligibility is based on the following:

- A member of the family must be a U.S. citizen or non-citizen with eligible status
AND
- The head of household must be 18 years of age or older
AND
- The family's total annual income must be below these Federal Income Limits:
