<b>Arrested</b>	Harold E. Brown, age 30, Madison Mr. Brown was arrested for Vehicle Owner's Liability for Hit & Run Property Adjacent to Highway, Obstructing, and on a Probation Violation.
<b>Victim</b>	Male, age 43, Madison
<b>Details</b>	<p>The dripping oil helped, but it what really aided the investigation were scratches and grooves cut into asphalt by a flat tire's rim. An MPD officer began following the clues after a hit-and-run driver smashed a car into a Doncaster Dr. home Saturday night. No one was injured, but the collision left a large hole in the siding. The suspect driver quickly drove away leaving the aforementioned evidence trails. They led to an apartment building in the 4500 block of Hammersley Rd. A white 2003 Ford Crown Victoria, with front-end damaged, was parked in building's lot. A police dog led officers from the car to the apartment building. The car's owner was inside, but did not wish to talk with police. He refused to answer the door. Another resident was more helpful, and officers were eventually able to question the suspect. He denied driving the damaged car, but his alibi turned out to be full of holes, and he was arrested on tentative charges listed above. The case remains under investigation and additional counts are possible. The suspect blew a .255 during a preliminary breath test at the Dane County Jail. It was administered nearly 3 hours after officers first picked up evidence trails laid down following the hit-and-run crash.</p>
