

TRANSIT PROFILE

The Madison Metro Transit system provides four times the average level of ridership per capita compared to transit systems of population peer group cities like Ann Arbor, Fort Wayne, Knoxville or Lincoln. Compared to all service level peer group cities like Albany, Spokane, Toledo or Omaha, the Metro Transit system has the highest level of trips per capita and the second highest in passenger trips per hour.
