

2012-2014 Pedestrian-Bicycle Projects

The Madison Pedestrian/Bicycle/Motor Vehicle Commission will hold a public hearing to receive comments on potential pedestrian and bicycle projects the City should consider undertaking in the 2012-2014 Capital Budget to increase opportunities for walking and bicycling in Madison. **The intent of the public hearing is to hear suggestions for new capital (construction) projects.** Please note that concerns about routine maintenance and operational issues can be directed to the appropriate agency or the City's Report-a-Problem webpage <http://www.cityofmadison.com/reportaproblem>.
