Dear Dog Owners;

Dog permits are required in all Dane County Parks and in designated City of Madison Parks.

To obtain your permit(s) when renewing you're dog license:

- ✓ **Complete** the application (reverse side)
- ✓ **Calculate** the total cost of your dog license, park permit, and any additional park permits.
- ✓ **Enclose** your license renewal notice, the completed park permit application, and a check, payable to the "City Treasurer," for the total license and park permit fees required for your household.
- ✓ **Mail** these to the City Treasurer,
 P O Box 20
 Madison WI 53701-0020

The license number will be filled in by the City Treasurer's Office when processing your renewals.

Permit Fees Help Support:

- Fencing costs for off-leash exercise areas.
- Creation & installation of necessary signs.
- Cost of providing and emptying receptacles used for feces disposal by dog owners.
- Miscellaneous Park maintenance (e.g., pathway mowing, etc.)

The annual permit gives you and your dog access to all Dane County Parks and designated City of Madison Parks. Each dog in your household going to a dog park must have a permit.
