Fees

The Lake Access Permit is a year-round permit required for all designated launch sites in the City of Madison, City of Monona, and Dane County Parks. Tax included in price.

Annual Dane County Resident	\$	30.00
Annual Non-Resident	\$	40.00
Dane County Senior (age 65 & up)	\$	15.00
Non-Resident Senior (age 65 & up)	\$	22.00
Disabled Person	\$	15.00
Duplicate/Replacement Permit	\$	12.00
Daily Permit	\$	8.00

Permits are required year-round. Please note that the 2010 permit will be valid until March 31, 2011.

Parking Violations

Parking on the grass is prohibited at ALL of the Madison Parks, including all boat launch sites. *Ordinance 8.16*
When the launch parking lot is full, you must find an alternative launch site. Vehicles that launch boats must purchase and display the proper Lake Access Permit.
Parking in the long stalls is for vehicles with trailers only. Parking in the short stalls is for single vehicles only. *Ordinance 8.21*



Tips for Safe Boating on Dane County Lakes

Respect the rights of other boaters:

Watch for ALL boats, swimmers and water skiers. Motorboats must yield the right-of-way to non-motorized watercraft.

Think before you drink:

Operating a boat while under the influence of intoxicants is ILLEGAL!

Control your boat's speed:

- Speed is a major factor in boating collisions.
- Know the limitations of your boat and how it handles in all sorts of conditions.
- Be alert for changes in weather conditions.
- Learn the meaning of waterway marker symbols and dive flags.

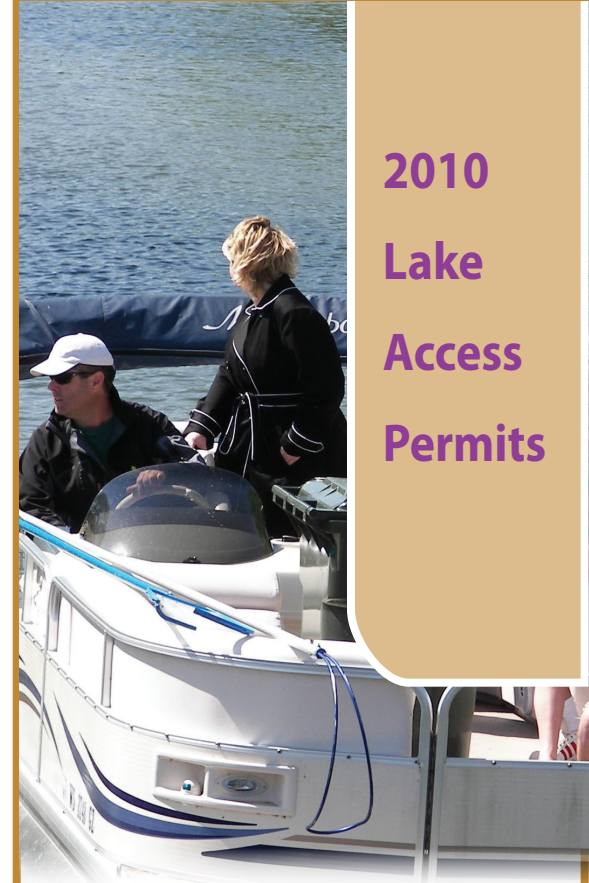
Wisconsin Boating Requirements:

- There must be a U.S. Coast Guard life preserver for each person on board.
- Lights must be ON sunset to sunrise.
- Battery must be covered and secured against shifting.
- Motorboats must be equipped with mufflers.
- Registration must be current and displayed properly.
