All applicants are required to meet with the Zoning Administrator and Planning staff prior to filing ALL applications for Plan Commission consideration.

**Notice Regarding Lobbying Ordinance:** If you are seeking approval of a development that has over 40,000 sq. ft. of non-residential space, *and/or* 10 or more residential units, *and/or* you are seeking assistance from the City with a value of \$10,000 (including grants, loans, tax increment financing, etc), you may be subject to the City's lobbying ordinance (Sec. 2.40, MGO). You are required to register and report your lobbying. Please consult the City Clerk's Office for more information. Failure to comply with the lobbying ordinance may result in fines.
