MEETING NOTICE

East Wilson Street/Schley Pass/Dewey Court Neighborhood Conservation Study

In August 2009, the Madison Common Council authorized a Neighborhood Conservation Study (NCS) for the East Wilson Street/Schley Pass/Dewey Court area (see map on reverse). The NCS is the next step in determining whether or not a neighborhood conservation district should be created to help preserve the unique, predominantly small-scale character of the study area as recommended in recent neighborhood plans.

The NCS will be prepared by City Planning staff working with residents, owners and businesses to define the special characteristics of the area in more detail, and to continue discussions regarding the desire and need for creating a neighborhood conservation district. To begin the NCS process, a kick-off meeting has been scheduled for:

At the meeting, staff will provide a brief overview of neighborhood conservation districts and the purposes of the neighborhood conservation study, and seek consensus on a process for conducting the study from those attending the meeting. If time permits, attendees will also be asked to participate in an exercise to begin to identify some of the attributes of the neighborhood that are considered most important in defining its character. Information needs for future meetings will also be discussed.

The success of the neighborhood conservation study will depend primarily on broad participation by residents, owners and businesses in the study area. If you are unable to attend the first meeting, you are encouraged to review background information, follow the progress of the study, and view future meeting dates on the project website:
