During the adoption process, at least <i>six</i> City Boards and Commissions (Plan Commission, Board of Public Works, CDBG Commission, Parks Commission, Ped/Bicycle/Motor Vehicle Commission, and Board of Estimates) will review the plan recommendations for approval. | IV. | Neighborhood Plan Implementation
The Hiestand Neighborhood Plan is an advisory document for initiating, directing and managing change within the neighborhood. Inclusion of neighborhood improvement projects in the capital or operating budgets, work plans, or other sources of funding from state or federal governments are possible ways to implement plan recommendations.
