- There's free parking at the meeting site and refreshments will be provided

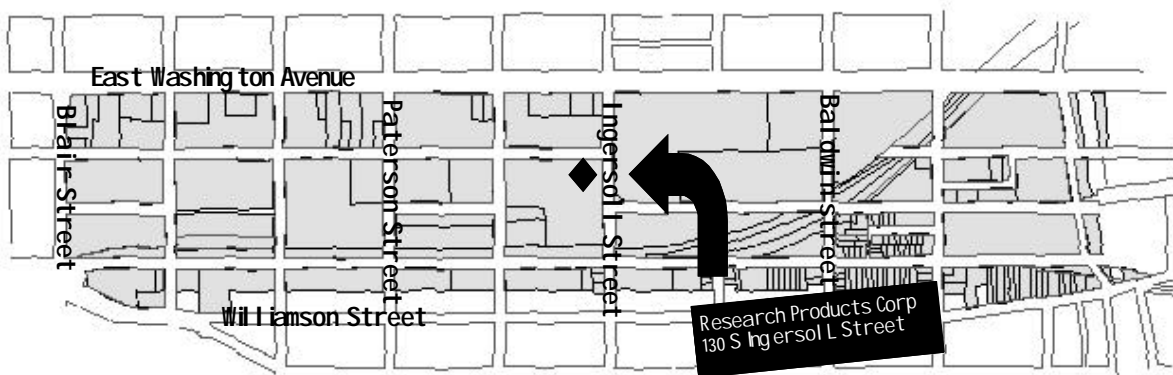

On Saturday, September 28th, from 9 AM to 12 Noon, the Phase Two draft recommendations for housing and the commercial and industrial uses within the "East Rail Corridor" will be presented and discussed!

The meeting is the fourth of several community-wide meetings to focus attention on land use planning for the East Rail Corridor area. The East Rail Corridor is an area bounded by East Washington Avenue, the Yahara River, East Wilson Street, and South Blair Street.

The main purpose of the meeting is to review and discuss the draft recommendations for housing and commercial and industrial uses developed by the East Rail Corridor Plan Advisory Committee. In addition, those who attend will be asked to provide feedback and direction to these critical land use issues and progress of the planning process will be reviewed.
