## **Alcohol Consumption: UW Football Saturdays**

### Don't Spoil Game Day with a Ticket from the Police!

The following is a list of the most common violated alcohol-related offenses and the associated fines:

|   | Fines          |
|---|----------------|
| <b>OPEN INTOXICANTS</b> are not allowed on any city street, sidewalk, terrace, alley or other public property.  | \$313          |
| UNDERAGE DRINKING - you must be 21 years old to drink or possess alcohol.   | \$376-<br>1006 |
| UNDERAGE DRINKING IN A BAR is against the law.  | \$376          |
| <b>BEING IN A BAR</b> is against the law if you are under 21 years of age, even if you are not drinking.  | \$376          |
| <b>FAKE ID's</b> include altered ID's, fake ID's, and using someone else's ID. Having one or using one is illegal.  | \$439          |
| PROCURING or furnishing alcohol to anyone under 21 is against the law.  | \$376          |
| <b>DISPENSING ALCOHOL</b> without a permit to anyone, even if they are of age, is illegal.  | \$691          |
| <b>DISORDERLY CONDUCT</b> is behavior that is violent, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud or otherwise able to provoke a disturbance. It's illegal. | \$439          |
| <b>OBSTRUCTING</b> a police officer includes lying or otherwise interfering with official duty. It's against the law.   | \$439          |
| URINATING anywhere other than a bathroom is unsanitary and against the law.   | \$187          |
| <b>UNREASONABLE NOISE</b> created by music or people at any hour of the day will not be tolerated.  | \$187          |

#### Please keep in mind . . .

- The City of Madison enforces all alcoholrelated violations during special events, including UW home football games.
- Out-of-State residents and persons without positive identification may be taken to jail.
- The University will be notified of all student violations and further actions may be taken.
- Private landlords are notified of certain violations that occur on their property.
- Persons deemed incapacitated by alcohol will be taken to a detoxification center at their expense.
