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Madison Senior Center Programs

Ongoing programs

- *Sunday meal:* An afternoon meal served monthly at the senior center and accompanied by entertainment, bingo and prizes.
- *Tuesday Matinee:* A bi-monthly screening of a popular film, accompanied by refreshments.
- *Thursday Dance:* A weekly dance with music provided by the Senior Showcase Band and refreshments.
- *Book Bites Series:* A monthly presentation by a local author accompanied by refreshments.
- *Computer lab:* A computer lab with 12 workstations used for various computer classes and open weekly to the public. Sponsorship would underwrite an upgrade of current software.
- *Scholarship fund:* A scholarship fund designed to assist low-income seniors with participation fees.

Intergenerational programs

- *Preschool crafts:* A monthly program connecting senior adults with preschool-aged children through fun and engaging craft projects.
- *Sixth Grade Essay Contest:* An annual contest in which local 6th grade students write an essay about an influential older adult in their lives. Celebration event features awards and food.

Annual Events

- *An Artful Affair:* An annual art show featuring the work of 55+ artists from Dane County. Opening coincides with Gallery Night and features refreshments and prizes.
- *A Photo Affair:* An annual photography show featuring the work of 55+ photographers. Opening coincides with Gallery Night and features refreshments and prizes.
- *Classic English Tea:* A major fundraiser for the Madison Senior Center held on Friday, December 10, 2010. Event includes a special refreshments, classical string quartet and festive decorations
- *Holiday Meal:* A meal on December 25th that serves about 125 older people who are alone for the holidays. This special meal includes appetizers, beverages, entertainment and bingo prizes.
- *Summer Picnic:* An outdoor event that features food, entertainment and bingo prizes. It also acknowledges the many volunteers of the Senior Center.
