2. 2023 Capital Budget

3. Budget Discussion

One of the larger capital costs in 2023 is the purchase of carpeting. With renovation scheduled for 2024 carpeting must be ordered in advance so it can be manufactured and delivered in time for installation. The majority of rooftop tiles are in need of replacement. Tile cost are up significantly, but it is also the first time in 25 years that this has been done. Several of the other capital requests are things that have been put off due to the pandemic and can no longer wait.
