APPROVAL OF MINUTES

May 19, 2022: A motion was made by Karofsky, seconded by Ring to approve the minutes. The motion passed by voice vote/ other.

NEW BUSINESS ITEMS

2. 2023 Operating Budget

A motion was made by Verveer seconded by Karofsky to recommend approval of the 2023 Operating Budget request. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

3. Budget Discussion

The guidance from the Mayor and City Finance was that all enterprise agencies submit an Operating budget that is consistent with the agency's revenue projections for 2023. The revenue projection is \$3.9M and the expense projections is \$8.7M. This is an increase in expenses of \$412,270. The Room Tax Fund contribution for 2023's Operating Expenses is anticipated to be \$4.8M which allows Monona Terrace to submit a balanced budget.

The increase in expenses comes from the rising cost of services and supplies, an increase in wages and benefits, along with the intention to fill some positions left open for salary savings during the pandemic, including the Associate Director position.
