As reconstruction of Phase I nears completion, work is well underway for the next phase. Phase II involves the reconstruction of the 200 block and is scheduled to begin in summer 2005. This meeting will focus on the proposed design for the 200 block. Anyone with an interest in the future look of State Street is encouraged to attend.



In April 2002, the City of Madison Common Council adopted the State Street Design Project Plan. This plan provided a conceptual design for the reconstruction of State Street and portions of adjacent streets.

The reconstruction of State Street is a complete reconstruction project encompassing a number of component parts and systems. In general this includes:

- > Roadway and utility infrastructure
- > Streetscape – pedestrian spaces
- > Lighting
- > District identity, wayfinding and signage
- > Public Art

The design project consultant team is currently refining the conceptual design to develop detailed construction plans for the 200 block.
