NEW LARGE ITEM COLLECTION

Before setting items out for pickup, you must complete a large item work order. In the form, you will choose when to set the items out and collection will occur during the work week following the set-out date you selected.

If you do not complete a work order, your large items will not be picked up.

In 2022 you will have more set-out opportunities than in 2021.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Yard waste is leaves, weeds, grass clippings, and similar material you have raked or pulled from your lawn or garden.

Residents receive two curbside pickup opportunities in the spring and three pickup opportunities in the fall.

BRUSH COLLECTION

Brush is woody material you have cut from your trees, shrubs, and bushes. The cut pieces must be at least 18 inches in length.

Brush collection begins in the spring and lasts through the summer. Residents receive multiple curbside collection opportunities.

DROP-OFF SITES

Hours for the drop-off sites change seasonally. Check the hours before loading your vehicle.
