TO: Property owners near the intersection of Segoe Road-Tokay Boulevard

SUBJECT: Conversion of the Segoe Road-Tokay Boulevard intersection to all-way stop control

An informational hearing will be held on Wednesday, February 20, 2008, at 6:30 p.m., in the cafeteria of Midvale Elementary School, 502 Caromar Drive, Madison, Wisconsin. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss some modifications to the intersection of Segoe Road-Tokay Boulevard necessary to convert it to all-way stop control.

Project Scope

The City of Madison Traffic Engineering Division was requested by local residents to review the intersection safety record and make recommendations for safety improvements at the intersection. Traffic Engineering staff have completed this review and determined that converting the intersection to all-way stop control is an appropriate improvement. This will include adding overhead stop signs and red flashing beacons to the new stop signs on Segoe Road. This will also require making the following geometric changes to the intersection:

- 1) Extending the south median nose to the intersection;
- 2) Relocating the crosswalk on the south side of the intersection so that it extends across Segoe Road parallel to Tokay Boulevard; and
- 3) Installing new curb on Constitution Lane at Segoe Road to square up the intersection.

Residents will quickly note that this median modification will eliminate the westbound Constitution Lane to southbound Segoe Road turning movement. Residents on Constitution Lane wishing to travel southbound on Segoe will need to use Holiday Drive to Dearholt Road. This change is considered necessary so we can create a pedestrian crossing ahead of stopped vehicles, rather than between vehicles at the intersection. It also eliminates an atypical traffic movement in the intersection.
