To: The Arbor Hills Neighborhood

A water supply improvement project is currently being developed for the Arbor Hills Neighborhood. To improve reliability and fire protection capacity to the Arbor Hills area, the Utility has evaluated several alternatives to improve the supply system and has recommended that a pump station be constructed. A full description of the project is posted on the Utility website at [www.madisonwater.org](http://www.madisonwater.org). The project is formally known as "**ARBOR HILLS SUPPLEMENTAL FIRE FLOW SUPPLY**".

A Citizen's Advisory Panel (CAP) has been formed for the project and is working closely with the Utility. The CAP has reviewed the report. A public meeting has been scheduled to review the recommendation of the Alternative Evaluation Report, to inform the public about the project, and to answer any questions that may come up as a result of this proposed project.
