The existing 100,000 gallon water tower was damaged in a fire on May 14, 2010 during a repainting operation. Rather than repair the existing tower the Madison Water Utility has decided to remove it and replace it with a new 400,000 gallon tower.

Work under this proposal will include preparing plans and specifications, obtaining necessary regulatory permits, performing construction observation, and assisting with public participation.
