## **Types of Force Used By Officers**

From July 1st through September 30th of 2022, Madison Police Officers responded to 36,241 calls for service. In that time, there were 84 citizen contacts in which officers used recordable force\* during their encounter. This means that in the 3rd quarter, MPD officers used recordable force 0.002% of the time when engaging with our citizens. Each of these force incidents documented by officers was reviewed for compliance with MPD standard operating procedures.
