## DANE COUNTY NARCOTICS TASK FORCE

## ANNUAL 2022 Summary

The Dane County Narcotics Task Force (DCNTF) is comprised of women and men from the City of Madison Police Department, Dane County Sheriff's Office, and the UW-Madison Police Department. Additionally, all Law Enforcement agencies in Dane County have the authority to send personnel to work with the DCNTF on shorter assignments as their own staffing allows. The mission of the DCNTF is to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking organizations within the Dane County area. The DCNTF also collaborates with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies in an effort to combat larger drug trafficking organizations.

At the start of 2022, the DCNTF set out several goals. These goals were to dismantle or disrupt two Drug Trafficking Organizations (DTO's). A total of five cases related to methamphetamine trafficking, continued community outreach, continued partnership with state and federal prosecutors, continued partnership with state and federal agencies, and reduction in violence related to narcotics trafficking.

In 2022, the DCNTF identified and dismantled six drug trafficking organizations. DCNTF collaborated with several state and federal agencies to dismantle these DTO's. The partnerships included local Dane County LE agencies, DCI, US Postal Inspectors, DEA, FBI and ATF.

In an effort to disrupt the methamphetamine trafficking in Dane County, the DCNTF issued 23 charges against suspected methamphetamine traffickers. This included 15 counts of delivery / manufacture methamphetamine, 3 counts of possession of methamphetamine, and 5 counts of possession with intent methamphetamine.

The DCNTF hosted several drug take back events in Dane County in October of 2022. We collaborated with WI DOJ, UW School of Pharmacy, Fountain of Life Church, Oak Wood Village and Safe Communities Madison-Dane County. In total 22 locations throughout Dane County participated in the drug take back in the fall of 2022.

The DNCTF was invited to present on the opioid epidemic at the Madison Metropolitan School District in-service. Two detectives provided an overview of current opioid trends seen in Dane County and an overview of the DCNTF.

The DCNTF continued to work with state and federal prosecutors on narcotics cases. Weekly meetings were held with state prosecutors on current drug cases being investigated by the DCNTF. Several cases were referred to the US Attorneys office for federal prosecution.

In the summer of 2022 the DCNTF collaborated with the US Attorney's Office to reduce gun related violence in Dane County. Several local, state and federal agencies met bi-

weekly on current gun related cases in Dane County. The DCNTF assisted with investigations and the apprehension of several violent offenders.

While enforcement is a critical component of combating illegal drugs and the correlating criminal activity, we recognize that this is only one part of the community effort that is necessary to reduce drug trafficking and drug dependency. We will continue to partner with those both inside and outside of LE as we combat this health and public safety issue.
