**Special Provisions ADD:**

**BID ITEM 90013 – TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION FENCE**

**DESCRIPTION**

This special provision describes furnishing and installing temporary construction fencing.

**MATERIALS**

Temporary Construction Fence materials shall include:

1. Free standing, 6 ft. tall temporary construction fence panels. Panels shall be of rigid, steel tube construction with chain link infill. Panels must be freestanding, requiring no surface penetrations for installation.
2. Fence stands. Fence stands shall be of rigid, steel tube construction and shall provide a stable platform for fence installation.
3. Sandbags or other suitable weights to secure temporary construction fence stands and panels.

### **CONSTRUCTION**

Fence shall be installed along the construction access route through Central Park from Ingersoll Street to the skate park site during high traffic periods (more than 10 trips per day by construction vehicles). Temporary fencing is only required along the south edge of the construction access route. Irrigation and electrical lines are located along the access route so fencing shall be a free-standing system.

### **METHOD OF MEASUREMENT**

Temporary Construction Fence shall be measured by the linear foot, acceptably installed. The measurement will be made from center of end post to center of end post.

### **BASIS OF PAYMENT**

Payment is full compensation for furnishing all temporary construction fence materials, including fence panels; fence bases; layout and installation of the fence; furnishing and placing fence panel weights; and for furnishing all labor, tools, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the contract work.
