1. GENERAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS

There are no changes to the general contract conditions.

2. GENERAL QUESTIONS/ANSWERS and CLARIFICATIONS

Q1. Can we bring a portable crusher on site for demolition of concrete?

- A1. Yes. A portable crusher may be brought on site for crushing concrete. If concrete is to be crushed the City will require the following:
 - Any/all metal be removed from the crushed material.
 - Crushed concrete shall be crushed to 100% passing a 1" sieve and 75% passing a 3/4" sieve.
 - Crushed concrete shall be repurposed on site as foundation fill material and as bid item 40102 Crushed Aggregate Base Course Gradation No. 2 BEFORE any bid item 40102 can be brought on site.

3. ACCEPTABLE EQUIVALENTS

No requests for alternates have been received therefore no alternates will be reviewed during the construction process.

4. SPECIFICATIONS

There were no changes to any of the written specifications in Exhibit B.

5. DRAWINGS

- A. The following changes were made to the Exhibit A Plan set. These corrected sheets will be published as Exhibit E.
 - i. Sheet 1; demolition and removal of 2 area light poles as follows:
 - Remove (2) existing security cameras and mounts, retain for reinstallation.
 - Remove (3) existing area lights and provide to Owner.
 - Remove and recycle (2) galvanized area light poles and (3) arms in their entirety.
 - Reuse existing conduit as much as possible
 - ii. Sheet 2; reinstall (2) salvaged PTZ cameras.
 - Reinstall both cameras under the northwest corner roof overhang.
 - One camera to point northerly to cover the Cold Storage building.
 - One camera to point southwesterly at the truck scale and Emil St. vehicle gate.
 - Reuse existing mounting brackets.
 - Install new data cable and conduit as per plan.
 - iii. Sheet 7; Install new conduit and data cables as needed
 - Connect new conduit to existing conduit underground
 - Install new conduit up inside NW corner of new building to roof overhang.
 - Install new data cables (estimated (2) at 300' each) from original source to cameras

6. **PROPOSAL**

There were no changes made to the proposal sheet. The above mentioned drawing changes shall be included with bid item 90000-Demolition of Existing Buildings.
