A quorum of the Police Civilian Oversight Board (PCOB) may be present at a community forum, focused on police accountability, public safety, and systemic reform following the Madison Police Department (MPD) officer killing of Corey Ruiz. This event is organized by the PCOB, in collaboration with the Community Response Team, Freedom, Inc., and the Social Justice Center.

Facilitated by Dr. Ananda Mirilli, the forum aims to bring community members together for structured discussion, advocacy, and coalition-building.

The forum will begin with light refreshments followed by introductions of the meeting hosts, table hosts, the sharing of ground rules, opening remarks, a world cafe style meeting and then a panel.

- **Corey Ruiz Case:** Context surrounding MPD's killing of Corey Ruiz and its aftermath.
- **Independent investigative oversight:** Process and legal protections
- **Policy Reform:** The 177+ adopted, but not implemented, changes to the Madison Police Department
- **The Office of the Independent Monitor**
- **Housing and homelessness.**
- **Civilian crisis response.**
- **Racial disparities and policy.**
- **Reflection and call to action.**
