1. Ranked in order based on score.

### 3. Outreach Coordination

Recommendations:

- Include all funded street outreach teams in development of project
- Try to provide 7 days a week of coordination

### 4. Housing Navigation

Recommendations:

- Engage in landlord recruitment strategies

### 5. RRH

It is the Review Team's understanding that the plan to prioritize Dairy Drive residents for the initial openings is not compatible with Coordinated Entry. HUD requires CoC-funded RRH to take participants directly from Coordinated Entry list in order of established prioritization.

Recommendations:

- Referrals are taken directly from Coordinated Entry for people who are unsheltered.
- Community conversation about identifying people experiencing unsheltered homelessness for prioritization (must include Lived Experience Committee and Youth Action Board)

Please note there needs to be a signed letter from CDA to get this funding, Brenda confirmed that they plan to have this signed this coming Friday.

- A motion to allow amendment to include 7 days a week coordination, motion was seconded, vote:
  - Passed unanimously
- Move to approve the funding slate
  - Passed unanimously

What happens next: add amendments, serve service needs, CoC application come together has one document and submitted by 10/20/22
