Quick Guide to Ineligible Voter List

Updated 2/2024

Discreetly check all Election Day registrations and absentee envelopes against this list. This is a list of felons known to live in your ward. It comes from the Department of Corrections.

If an absentee voter's name is on the ineligible voter list, contact the Chief Inspector. You will be the challenger in the challenge process.

If the name of someone registering to vote is on the list, tell them that they can register when they are Off Paper. Give the voter one of the green handouts from the Ineligible Voter List folder.

Sometimes the ineligible voter list is a little outdated. If the voter says they are Off Paper or not serving a felony sentence, we can follow up. Call the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) at (608) 266-8005. WEC may be able to confirm that the voter is eligible.

If WEC cannot confirm eligibility and the voter says they are eligible to vote, contact the Chief Inspector. You will go through the challenge process with this voter.

It is not our job as poll workers to investigate or be a judge. The District Attorney will investigate after Election Day.
