



Our Goal

Our goal is that each eligible voter will be able to cast a ballot, and have that ballot counted.



Election Day

- ★ Polls open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- ★ First Shift: 6 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- ★ Second Shift: 1 p.m. until tally is complete




Task Rotation

- ★ Chief Inspector is in charge
- ★ You will be paired with an experienced poll worker
- ★ You will rotate tasks throughout your shift



Greeter Station

- ★ Welcome voters
- ★ Ward map and addresses
- ★ If from another ward, guide to correct polling location




Greeter Station

- ★ Are you registered to vote at your current address?
- ★ Unsure, check forward directory
- ★ Have you moved since you last voted?
- ★ Let's verify your ward



Poll Book Station (Voter)

- ★ States name and address
- ★ Shows ID
- ★ Signs poll book
- ★ Takes voter slip

- ★ Two poll books per ward
- ★ Supplemental list in back of poll book lists everyone who registered within 20 days of election

- ★ “Did you return an absentee ballot?”
- ★ If returned, may not vote at the polls
- ★ If not returned, may vote at the polls



Poll Book Station (Seat 1)

- ★ Ask voter to state name & address
- ★ Locate voter in poll book
- ★ Provide page number to Seat 2



- ★ Each voter is assigned a sequential number
- ★ Write ward number in blank




Poll Book Station (Voter Slips)

- ★ Color coordinated with poll books, ballots
- ★ Use highlighter if ballot style highlighted on poll book (wards with multiple school districts)



Poll Book Station (Seats 1 & 2)

- ★ Record number on poll book
- ★ Voter exchanges voter slip for ballot at next station



This receipt is valid until 10-31-2011, unless otherwise cancelled, revoked, suspended or disqualified by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. If you have not received your Driver License in 15 days, please contact DMV using the information above. Beginning June 1, 2010 no person may operate a motor vehicle in this State unless the owner or driver of the vehicle has liability insurance in effect for the vehicle being operated and carry proof of insurance whenever driving. Law Enforcement may ask for proof of insurance at any traffic stop or accident. Failure to have insurance could result in up to a \$500 fine. Failure to have proof, when requested could result in a \$10 fine. You do not need proof of insurance when registering a vehicle or obtaining a driver license, unless DMV specifically requested proof of financial responsibility (SR-22) after a revocation or suspension. Refer to Wis Stat 344.61-344.65 for full detail.

Acceptable Voter ID

★ Certificate of Naturalization issued within last 2 years



Acceptable Voter ID

- ★ Tribal ID, regardless of expiration
- ★ Any federally recognized Tribe



Acceptable Voter ID

- ★ ID issued by an accredited Wisconsin university or college
- ★ Student name
- ★ Student signature
- ★ Date card was issued
- ★ Expires within 2 years of issuance



Acceptable College Student Voter ID

- ★ UW Voter Identification Card is valid
- ★ Edgewood Student ID is valid
- ★ Madison College One Card may be valid
- ★ UW faculty ID is not valid
- ★ UW WisCard is not valid
- ★ High school ID cards are not valid




Expired College Voter ID

- ★ If ID is expired, student needs to show a separate document (paper or electronic) proving current enrollment
- ★ If ID is not expired, no proof of enrollment is necessary



Proof of Current Enrollment

- ★ Only if college ID is expired
 - ★ Tuition fee receipt
 - ★ Enrollment verification form
 - ★ Class schedule
 - ★ Housing contract
 - ★ Current, signed ASM bus pass



- ✓ Acceptable type of ID
- ✓ Acceptable expiration date
- ✓ Name reasonably conforms to poll book
 - ✓ Bob conforms to Robert
 - ✓ Sue conforms to Susan
 - ✓ Bucky conforms to Buckingham
 - ✓ Smith-Jones conforms to Smith or Jones



Checking Voter ID

- ✓ Reasonably resembles voter
 - ✓ Remember, photo may be 10 years old
 - ✓ Not appropriate to make comments about voter's photo



Checking Voter ID

- ★ Address on ID is not relevant and is not compared to the poll book
- ★ Voter states current address

- ★ Driver license/ID from another state



- *Write name and address on scratch paper
