

My Voting Plan



Step One: Voter Registration (choose one)

- I checked <https://MyVote.wi.gov>, and my voter registration is up-to-date.
- I have a current WI ID, and will register to vote at <https://MyVote.wi.gov> by October 19.
- I will register to vote by mail, with [proof of address](#), by October 19.
- I will register to vote with [proof of address](#) at the Clerk's Office before October 25.
- I will register to vote at an [In-Person Absentee Voting site](#) with [proof of address](#), Oct. 25 - Nov. 4.
- I will register to vote with [proof of address](#) at the [polls](#) on Election Day.



Step Two: Voting Options (choose one)

- [Absentee by mail](#) – request by October 24 to make sure I receive it in time.
See Absentee via Mail in step three.
- Vote [absentee in person](#), Oct. 25 - Nov. 6
See Early Voting in step three.
- Vote [at the polls on Election Day](#)
See Election Day in step three.
- Vote [curbside](#) at the polls on Election Day
See Election Day in step three.



Step Three: Cast My Ballot (choose one)

Absentee via Mail

- Make sure envelope is sealed, signed by me, signed by a witness, and lists witness' complete address.
- Return absentee through the mail – Mail back by Monday, October 24, to be safe
- Deliver absentee to a [ballot drop-off site](#) before November 7
- Deliver absentee to an [absentee voting site](#), Oct. 25 - Nov. 6
- Deliver absentee to the City Clerk's Office (open weekdays 8:00am -4:30pm) before October 25
- Deliver absentee to my [polling place](#) on Election Day

Early Voting/In-Person Absentee

- Vote [absentee in person](#), Oct. 25 - Nov. 6

Election Day

- Cast my ballot at my [polling place](#) on Election Day (I may use my own black or blue ballpoint pen)
- Cast my ballot at the curb of my [polling place](#) on Election Day (look for Vote Here flag)
