Households must live within the MOM service area, which is West Madison (west of Midvale Blvd., north of the Beltline), Middleton, and Cross Plains or live in/have a child enrolled in the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District to be eligible for services.

Food Pantry Boxed Meal Pick-Up Times:

Tuesdays - 12pm - 1:30pm

Thursdays - 12pm - 1:30pm

Saturdays - 10am - Noon

We ask that people in need of a food box only pick-up **once per week in order to limit interactions** and make sure that we have adequate supply.

All distributions include non-perishable food items, refrigerated items, frozen meat (depending on availability), and milk.

#### **The following system will be in place for client pickup:**

1. Enter through our main driveway entrance and follow the cones. Please stay to the right to allow for passage out of the parking lot.
2. A volunteer will ask you the basic questions and ask to see your ID, all while you stay in your car.
3. A volunteer will then put the food in your car.

We will be continuing service of pre-packed boxes throughout this crisis.

If you are not feeling well and need food, we encourage you to stay home. **You may send a proxy shopper in your place.** Proxy shoppers do not need to be registered during this emergency period of time.

Curbside Pick-up Instructions:

-Please maintain a single line of cars, **remain in your vehicle** and follow directions given by the volunteer.

The volunteer will ask for the following:

**-ID** for head of household.

-If you are new to BPNN, or have not used the BPNN food pantry in the past 12 months, **show proof of current address** such as a bill received in your name dated within the past 60 days.

Pre-boxed and bagged groceries will be loaded into your vehicle by the BPNN volunteer, and your identification will be returned. Please make sure your vehicle trunk, seats and floor are empty so groceries may be loaded, and social distancing can be observed.
