The City of Madison Adult School Crossing Guard program is recruiting in your neighborhood. Specifically, we are looking for permanent guards to staff the corners of **Raymond Road/Leland Drive and Whitney Way/Russett Rd**, serving students attending Orchard Ridge Elementary and Toki Middle School. As a Crossing Guard, you will help safeguard students on their way to and from school, morning and afternoon. **Help us finish the school year strong, thru June 6**, and if you'd like, return with us for the 2024-25 school year!

This Crossing Guard works part-time, 10 hours per week (one hour in the morning and one hour in the afternoon). Work is Monday through Friday. **Starting pay is \$19.86/hour** (approximately \$700+/month) plus regular raises and earned sick leave.
