How to use Municode

The City of Madison Code of Ordinances Homepage Navigation:

1. Date of the latest updates
 - a. Click on the arrow to see prior revisions.
2. View what's changed includes a list of latest revision changes.
3. A list of Council adopted ordinances not yet codified is also included.
 - a. Click on each ordinance to see the details adopted by council.
4. Sign up for changes notifications, stay connected.
5. The left of the screen contains links for each of the 45 Chapters for the City of Madison
6. The code can be search using keywords.




How to use Municode

Navigate to a chapter:

- 1- You can use the search box or the tree.



Example: Searching for ordinance reference in Legistar 79504

e.g. Searching for 23.07(6)(a) and (b) & 13: Chapter 23, Section 7 & Sub-Section (a) & (b)

- 1 Scroll to the chapter of interest (23)
- 2 Locate the specific section (23.07)
- 3 File 79504, removes 6 (a) (b) & the reference to (6) under section 13
- 4 Section (2) defines trespassing in private

(13) Any person violating any of the provisions of Subsections (1), (2) or (11) of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture of up to five hundred dollars (\$500); any person violating any provision of Subsection (3), (9) or (10) of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1000); any person violating any provision of Subsection (4) or (8) of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200); and any person violating any of the provisions of Subsections (5) or (6) or (7) of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300).
