What is the consent agenda? DEFINITION

A **consent agenda** is a process that allows a large number of agenda items to be bundled together and passed <u>with one</u> motion without discussion.

What is the consent agenda? EXAMPLES

The consent agenda includes files that are passing without discussion. Typical consent agenda items are routine, procedural decisions, and decisions that are noncontroversial.

Examples may include:

- Routine matters such as appointments to committees
- Routine resolutions approving plans, improvements, etc.
- Reports provided for information only
- Correspondence requiring no action

What is the consent agenda? MORE INFO

It is used by the Council:

- to streamline passage of legislative files
- to preserve meeting time for questions and discussion

Through the "bundling" process, the entire set of routine agenda items can be voted on in one action versus taking the time to vote on each individual item.

What is the consent agenda <u>document</u>? DEFINITION

The **consent agenda document** contains files excluded from the consent agenda for discussion, as well as files provided for reference and files which have been updated from the agenda.

What is the consent agenda <u>document</u>? SECTIONS

EXCLUSIONS: The consent agenda document contains files excluded from the consent agenda.

- Excluded by alder
- Excluded due to registrants wishing to speak

OTHER SECTIONS: The document contains four additional sections provided for reference or as an update to the agenda.


- Supermajority items
- Recommendations different from agenda
- Items to be introduced from the floor (notify Council staff if known in advance)
- Corrections to clerical errors on the agenda


TIMELINE: Agenda published Thursday
