Consumer Protection (Weights and Measures)

- Gas pumps, bar code scanners, grocery store and other scales, taxi meters, timing devices: coin operated dryer, etc.
- About 1000 licensed locations per year
- 20k-25k devices





Health and Welfare

- Exterior Property Maintenance
  - Junk / Trash / Debris
  - Tall Grass / Weeds
  - Snow / Ice clearing of public sidewalks (580 snow citations this season)
  - Dead / dying trees
  - Street / sidewalk obstructions / vision clearance
  - 1 and 2 family erosion control
- 3,999 cases (2022)





Plan Review and Inspection

- \$651 million in new construction in 2022
- Added 3633 dwelling units (90% apartments)
- 1546 plan reviews
- 11 inspectors, average 15 inspections a day
- Inspectors carry about 2500+ open permits



Systematic Code Enforcement





- Exterior of Existing buildings: Inspections of any building
- Interior inspections: residential common areas rental dwelling units, also any other building upon complaint or referral.
- We inspect, educate on code requirements and instruct on matters to be corrected
- 1,077 Housing cases (2022)
- 10 inspectors

• Process about 650 sign permits annually

What is the Zoning Tourist Rooming House Permit?

The ZTRHP1 Permit allows the operation of a TRH for stays of one night or more. If host is present when guests stay, there is no limit to the number of rental nights;

if host is not present there is a 30-night maximum that the TRH may operate. This must be host's primary residence.\*

Who can operate a TRH?

TRHs can be operated by home owners, or by tenants if explicitly allowed in the lease.

#### Family Definition Revision

The family definition is part of our zoning code. It restricts the number of people who can live in an apartment or house together in Madison based on:

- zoning district;
- whether they are renters or homeowners; and
- whether they are related to one another.

Over 1/3 of the land area in Madison is zoned to prohibit more than two unrelated renters from living together. In these same areas, owner-
