# FAQ Answers



### Am I registered to vote?



- You can verify your voter registration at <u>https://MyVote.wi.gov</u>.
- If you have moved, you will need to re-register.
- If your address is up-to-date with the DMV, you can register online at <u>https://MyVote.wi.gov</u> up to 20 days before Election Day.

Once the status of the minutes or proceedings has changed from Draft to Approved

- Meets accessibility requirements
- Within ward, if possible
- Serves only one ward, if possible
