These vehicles have a much higher initial cost to purchase and require infrastructure equipment and upgrades. The scope of this project is to fund electric refuse trucks for the Streets and Parks divisions. The funding will also provide the necessary charging infrastructure equipment and installation.

Funding in 2023 will be used for a tower truck, fire engine, two ambulances, two electric water crafts and two electric command vehicles.

This program funds the replacement of the City's general fleet. The program's goal is to replace vehicles in accordance with the master replacement schedule ensuring city staff have access to safe, reliable vehicles when providing their services. Funding in 2023 will be used to purchase 125 pieces of equipment, including replacement of City sedans, trucks, refuse equipment, mowers, tractors, trailers, and Police squads.
