External: Can the City of Madison tell internet service providers where they need to provide service or better service in Madison?

A: The City does not directly regulate telecommunications providers (providers) in Madison. We do require them, and any entity occupying the right-of-way, to register with us, and they must get various permits when they work in the right-of-way. We are able to tell providers where they can place their facilities, but we do not control whether or how they use the right-of-way for their business. Any provider that is registered with the State has a legal right to place and maintain facilities in the right-of-way, and we cannot take that right away from them.

It is up to them whether they invest in upgrades to their system, abandon their facilities, or even sell their facilities. There is nothing, except for its own financial, technical, and infrastructure constraints, stopping any telecommunication provider from expanding or upgrading its service to compete with other providers in more areas of the City. In the past we've encouraged providers to expand or improve their service to certain areas of the City, but there is little we can do to actually make that happen.

A: The City does not directly regulate telecommunications providers (providers) in Madison. You can reach out to Public Service Commission (PSC) of Wisconsin, who has established an Internet & Phone helpline for Wisconsin consumers. Please dial (608) 267-3595 to speak with dedicated PSC staff or leave a voicemail.

Configuring a City Exchange e-mail account on a smartphone

Please refer to your device's user guide for detailed Exchange e-mail account setup instructions, as the setup steps vary by manufacturer and/or device. Most email setup will be located under Settings/Mail – choose Exchange. All Android, Windows, and iPhone's will ask for the following information:

Email	Your full city e-mail address, i.e. asmith@cityofmadison.com
Server	email.cityofmadison.com
Domain	city
Username	Two letter City department abbreviation and your own initials, i.e. itabc
Password	Your network (outlook) password

Internal: How do I access my email on my own device?

External Access

A:

To access your email from home, go to <u>email.cityofmadison.com</u>. Enter your Network username (for example, **isabc**) and password (the password you use to login to your computer each day).

Outlook WebAccess allows you to remotely access your messages, calendar, and global address book. You cannot access any archived email or personal address books.

Secure Outlook Mailbox with a Password

With your Outlook mailbox open:

- Select Tools, Email Accounts
- When the E-Mail Accounts Wizard appears, select "View or Change existing e-mail accounts" and click Next.
- On the next screen, highlight Microsoft Exchange Server and click on the "Change" button.
- Select the "More Settings" button.
- Select the "Security" tab, and under "User identification", check the box that says, "Always prompt for user name and password."
- Click the "OK" button
- Click the "Next" button
- Click the "Finish" button

The next time you login into Outlook you will have to key in your username and password. The *username* field will require that you type in **city**\ along with your *username*; for example, **city**\ **isabc**. Your username alone will not work. The password for Outlook will be the same as your network password.

Internal: I've locked my email account who do I contact?

A: Outlook passwords are encrypted so we cannot tell you what your password is. We can, however, reset it. Call the Help Desk at (608) 266-4193 and we will be happy to reset it for you during normal business hours, Monday – Friday, 8a.m. – 4:30p.m.



Internal: Can IT support me on my personal device?

DANEnet is working with the City of Madison to ensure all members of the Common Council have access to the technology and digital skills they need to productively participate in the Common Council via Zoom meetings and independent work.

DANEnet will also be able to provide tech support. You should reach out to the Common Council Office on scheduling a time with DANEnet.
