Equity refers to the measures we take to help the people in Madison rise up. *It is how we serve.*



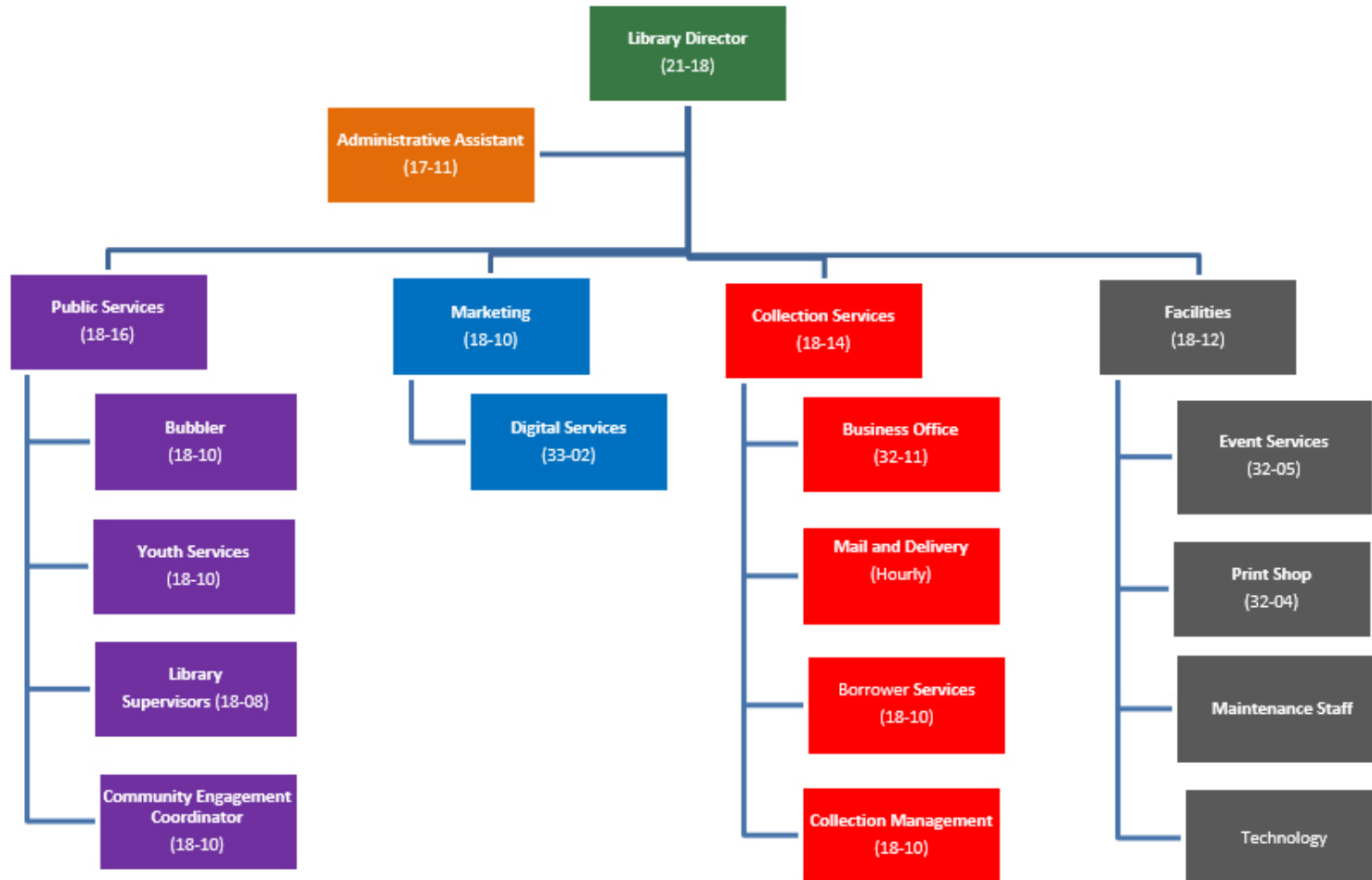
Accountability means we take responsibility for our actions and produce results. *It is our promise.*
