- greatly reduce Metro's carbon footprint



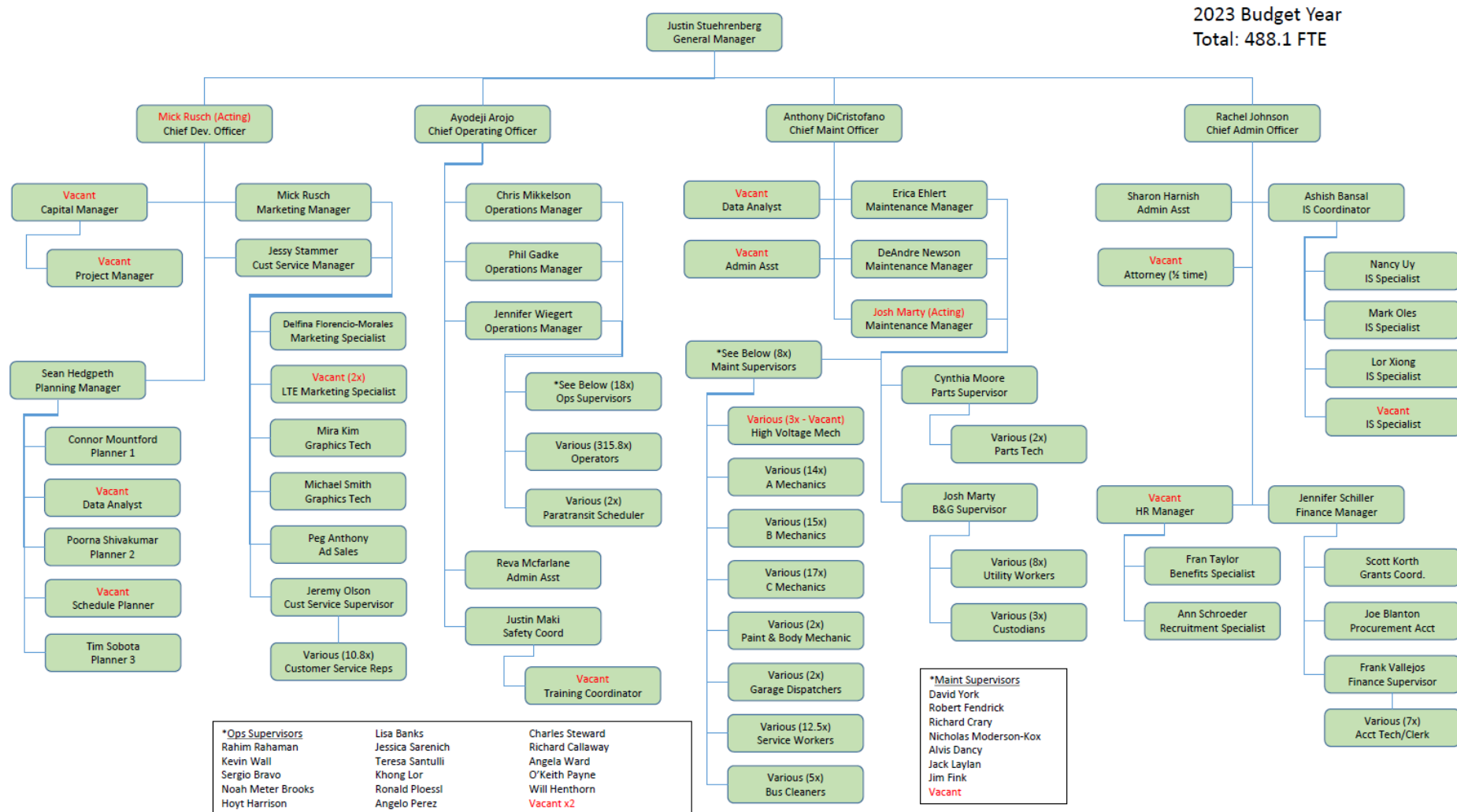
Mission
