

# Youth Violence Prevention 2023 Funding Opportunity Overview

Deadline: 4:30 pm CST on April 3rd 2023

**Objective:** As part of a broader strategy to mitigate conditions that contribute to youth violence, the City is again investing \$420,000 of federal funding it received through the State and Local Recovery Funds component of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) into youth violence prevention-focused summer programming. Funding will be used to support youth violence prevention strategies approved by the Mayor's Office for summer 2023.

**Target Population:** The target population for this funding opportunity is youth and young adults ages 14-26 who previously have been, currently are, or at-risk of being involved with the juvenile justice system.

## **Recommendations for Youth Summer Programming/Strategies**

- Strengthen Neighborhood Centers for Youth Opportunities and as Resources for Families in areas or neighborhoods that may be under-resourced
- Provide space and resources to empower young people to become violence prevention advocates and speak out against behaviors that promote violence
- Support youth engagement and leadership in their neighborhoods with Parks Alive events
- Expand or enhance sexual violence and teen dating violence prevention programs and practices that also address the needs of LGBTQIA+ youth
- Increase employment and workforce development opportunities for youth and young adults ages 14-26 in or at high-risk of juvenile justice involvement
