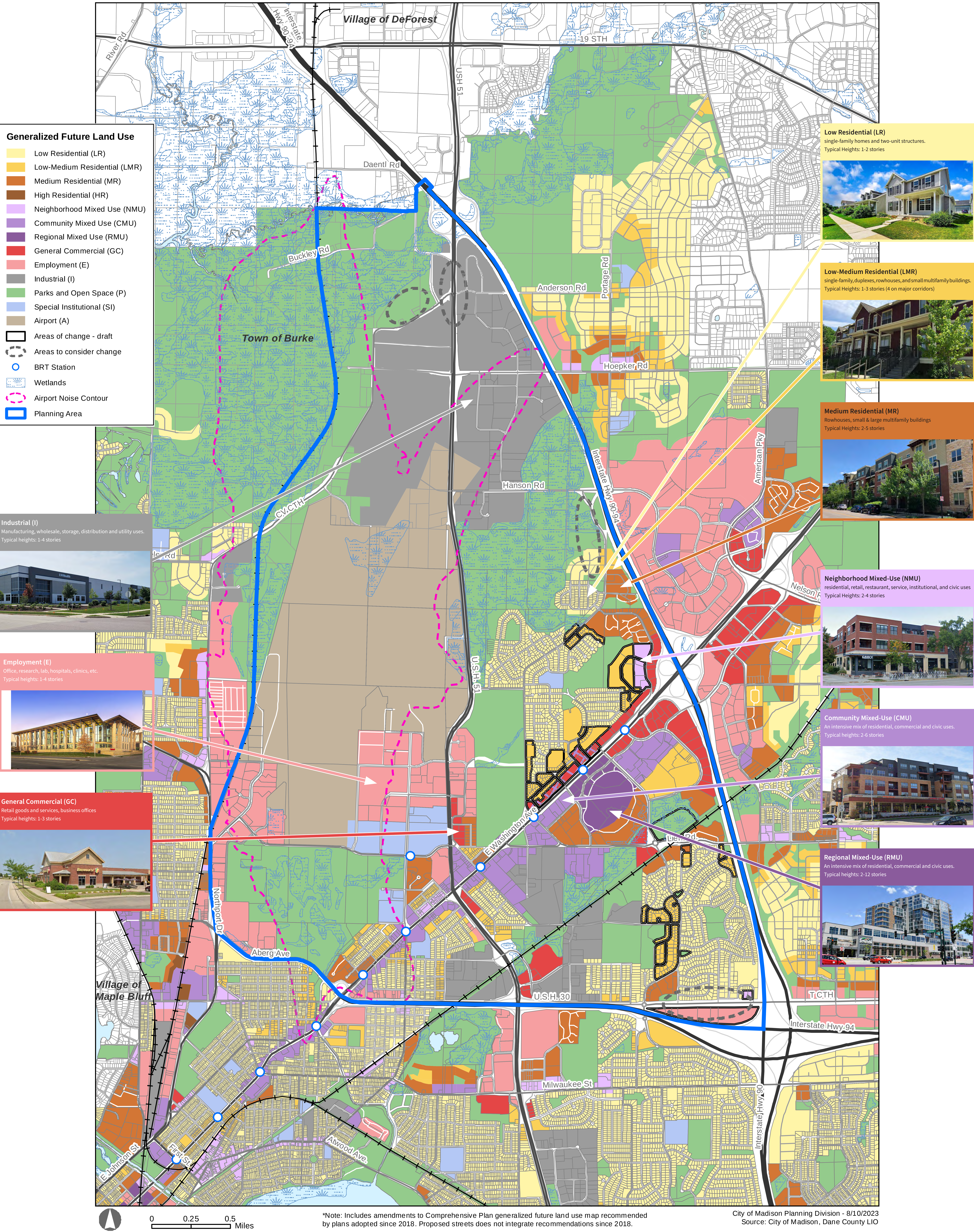

E Washington Ave and Independence Ln

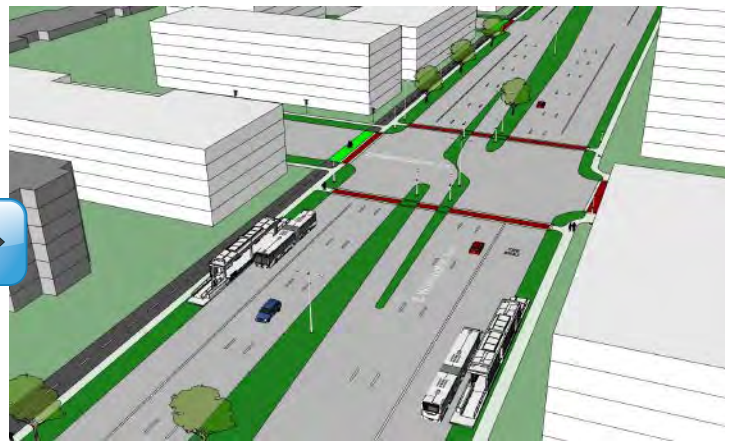
What we heard

- Unsafe for pedestrians and bicyclists to cross
- Lacking visual appeal and community character
- Absence of visual cues for slowing down vehicles
- Confusing car turning movements
- Inactive public spaces with limited bike access
- Inadequate tree canopy
- Buildings set far from street, creating an unwelcoming pedestrian space



What if we...

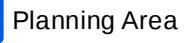
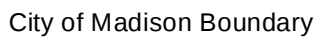
- Redevelop frontage road
- Enhance corridor unity
- Streamline intersection dynamics by simplifying car turning movements and allowing for smoother traffic flow that helps reduce congestion
- Include bike infrastructure
- Improve pedestrian safety with a more visible pedestrian crossing and a beacon light
- Add urban density and bring buildings to the front of the road

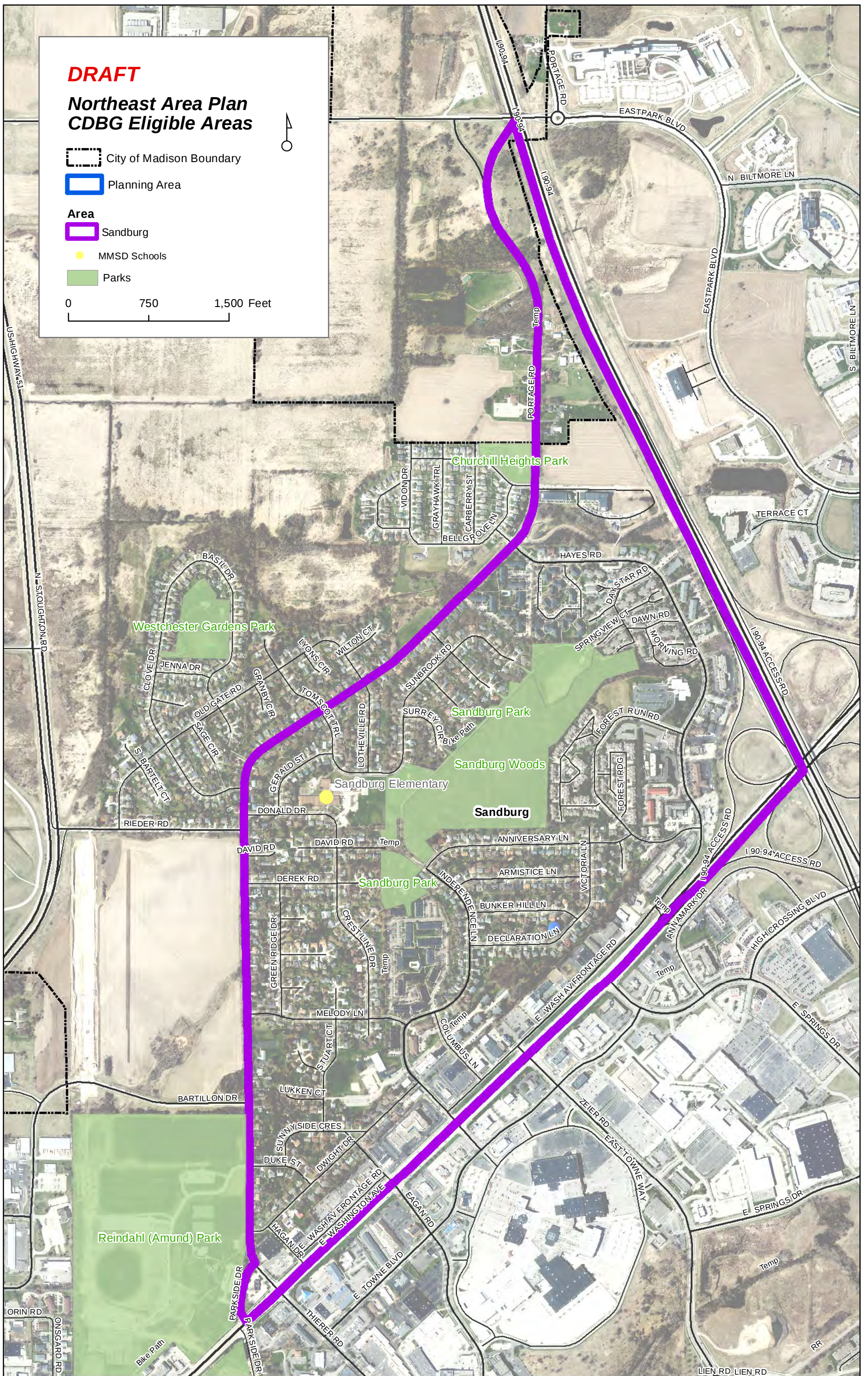

Potential Community Action Projects in Sandburg & Burke Heights

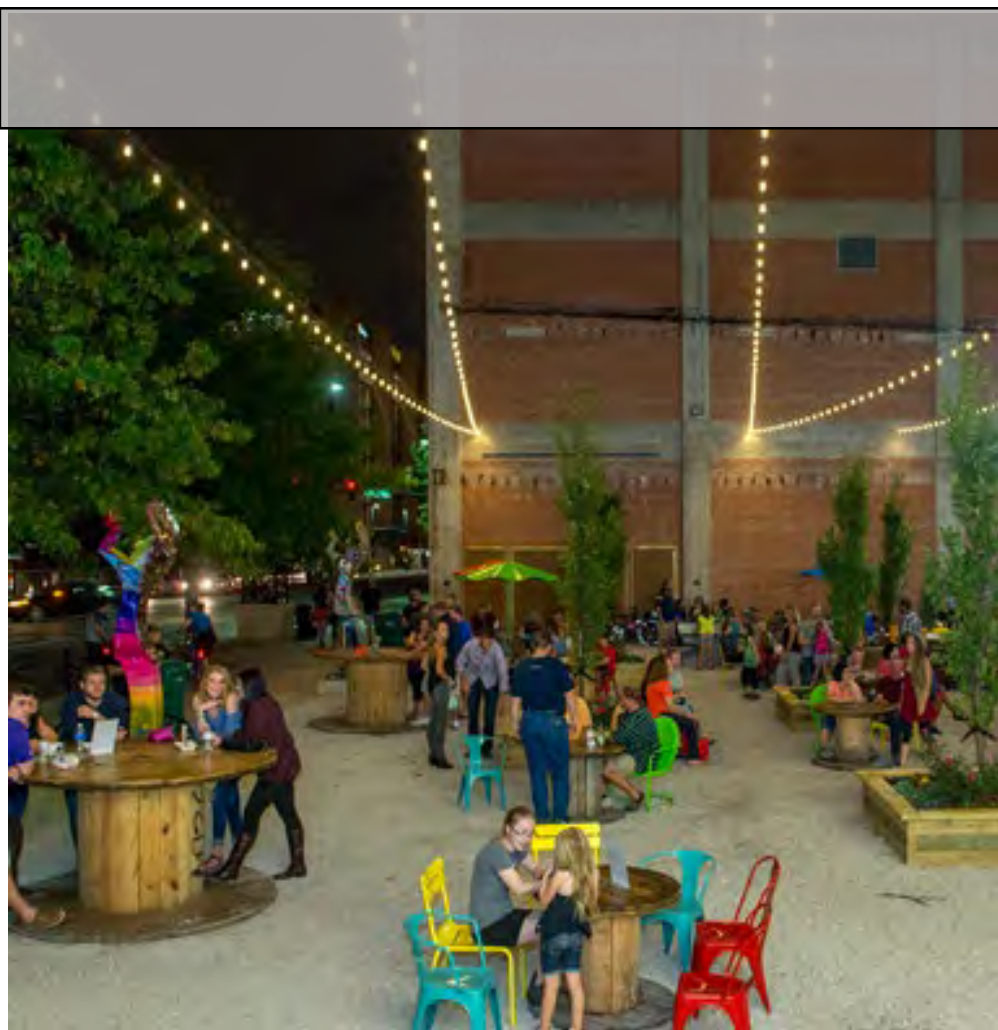
