- WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Madison to promote community awareness of the many cultural opportunities in Madison; and
- WHEREAS, a city committee is needed to provide a liaison between cultural groups, the university, and governmental bodies; and
- WHEREAS, the Common Council is frequently asked to provide space and funding for cultural groups,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Cultural Affairs Committee be formed to coordinate and advise the Common Council in matters relating to cultural affairs in the City of Madison.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall consist of 5 members; 4 citizens and 1 alderman to be appointed by the Mayor and subject to confirmation of the Council. The full Committee shall be appointed forthwith, but two of the citizen terms shall expire on the third Tuesday of April, 1974; and two of the citizen terms and the aldermanic term shall expire on the third Tuesday of April, 1975. Thereafter, citizen appointments shall be made for two year terms and the aldermanic appointment shall be for a one year term.
